Python Brasil is the largest Python programming language conference in South America.

Each year, the event is hosted in a different city in Brazil and is entirely organized by volunteers from the local community.

This year, it will be hosted in Caxias do Sul, RS, from October 30th to November 5th.

Our goals are as follows:

- To promote the widespread use of Python;
- To facilitate the exchange of knowledge and experiences;
- To contribute to our community's growth while also generating a positive socioeconomic impact on the region.

In-person Event

In our 19th edition, we will convene in Caxias do Sul again, marking our return 14 years after our inaugural event.

This year's conference, scheduled from October 30th to November 5th, will offer a diverse content encompassing both theoretical and practical activities. Participants will have the invaluable opportunity to engage with some of the most prominent figures in both the national and international Python communities.

As is tradition, the event will kick off with tutorials held at the local university, *Universidade de Caxias do Sul*, providing attendees with hands-on experiences and valuable insights into the practical facets of the conference.

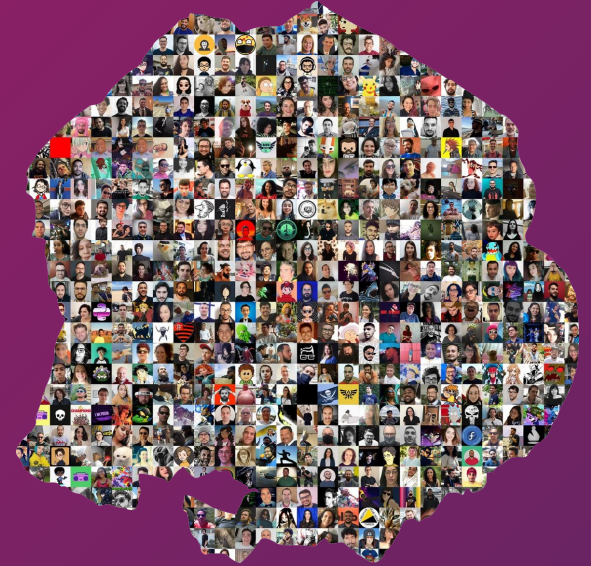
From **November 2nd to November 4th**, our program will include **lectures**, a **job fair**, and **keynote** presentations.

On **November 5th**, we will reconvene at *Universidade de Caxias do Sul* for coding **sprints**, allowing everyone with the chance to contribute to open-source projects actively.

Online event

During the Covid-19 pandemic, Python Brasil adapted by moving online in 2020 and 2021. This shift led to record-breaking audiences and a more decisive fulfillment of its mission to share knowledge and foster community interaction across various regions, nationally and globally.

Due to the success and community demand, Python Brasil will live-stream talks on YouTube in real-time in 2022 and maintain this practice in 2023.



Online event



To participate, individuals should register for free on Eventbrite. Upon registration, they will receive access to the official event Discord server. Here, they can engage with speakers, submit questions, and participate in job fairs with our sponsors.

While the official online event kicks off on November 2nd with the main activities, it's worth noting that our online team will be active on Discord from the very first day, preparing for the event.

Online Job Fair



Job fair is the term used to describe a dedicated space for companies to have direct contact with participants.

It is most commonly used for recruitment and promoting the company itself, but it can also be used for showcasing products and services.

An online job fair is a dedicated space within the event's online environment, specifically on Discord, where companies can connect with the audience following Python Brasil from their homes.

Each company will have a dedicated text channel for interacting with participants and specific schedules for voice and video channels, which **will be announced as part of the event's program.**

In person Job Fair



Like the online version, the in-person Job Fair is also a space dedicated to companies directly contacting participants.

It is often used for recruiting and publicizing the company but can also be used to showcase products and services.

The in-person job fair will be held in a dedicated space at the physical event, with set times that **will be announced as part of the event program.**

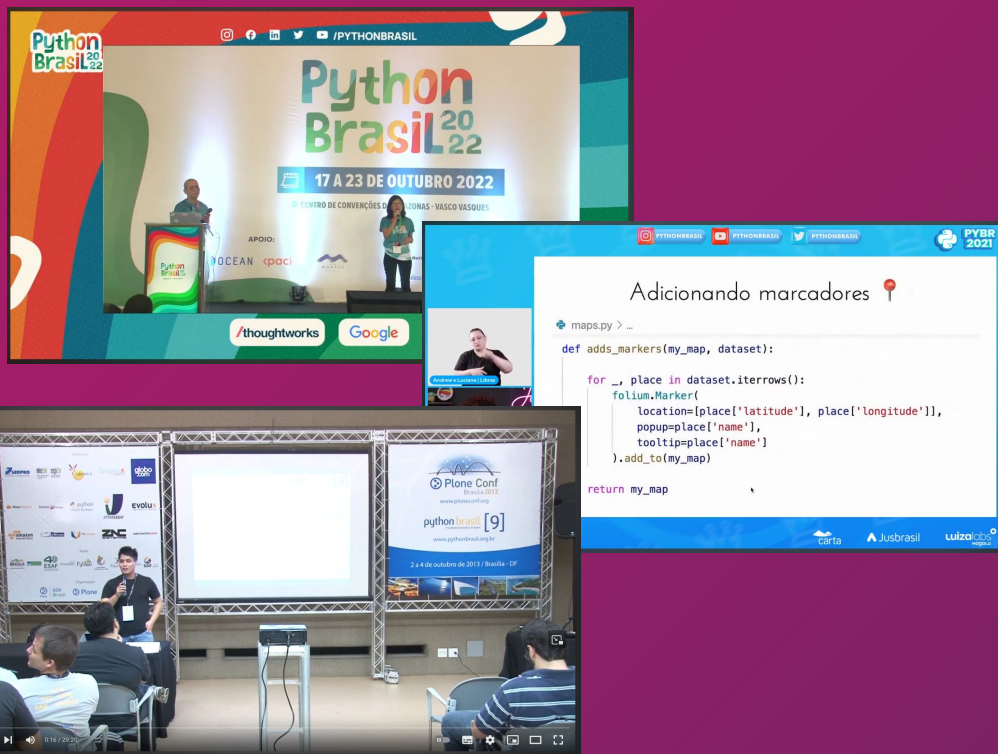
Logo on the event badge*
